Transportation Plan Committee Meeting Monday

(Nampa, February 5, 2010) A community advisory committee working with the City of Nampa to develop a long-range transportation plan will meet for the third time on Monday, February 8, 3:30 to 5:30 p.m. at the Nampa Civic Center.

Committee members will help develop the city's criteria for choosing future transportation projects. In this meeting the committee will be asked to rank dozens of factors like cost, accident rates and pavement condition, with the top-ranked factors becoming part of the criteria.

Nampa launched a citywide planning process to address automobile, freight, transit, pedestrian and bicycle traffic needs through the year 2035. The resulting Nampa Citywide Transportation Plan will be released for public comment this spring.

Committee members include business and property owners, citizens, elected officials, educators and advocacy groups. All meetings are open to the public.

A community open house will be held in late spring 2010 to gather comments on the draft transportation plan and a list of future projects.
